

# Book Blog

In lieu of a daily reading log, students will be required to complete 2 book blogs per month. A book blog is a response to a reading question that has been posted on Kid Blog. Questions will center around topics such as author's craft, theme, mood/tone, etc. Questions should be answered based on the student's independent reading book.

## Requirements:

- 2 blog posts per month
- 2 responses per blog post
- Complete sentences
- Book title and author included in blog post
- Correct punctuation, spelling, and grammar
